Change The Game, Shunt The Queue

Good morning world, I want to say Happy New Year to everyone and most especially those who are sharing this calendar with us, we want to say Happy New Year do have a great and wonderful year about 2017.

This is Expose 247 where we reveal Christ by *going* through all the pages of Old testament and New Testament, and lately we are on a Knock series after the prodigal father series we had some weeks back. And in this Knock Out series we are trusting the Lord using the hammer of God's Word to cast down every imagination, every high sounding principles and philosophy that is antichrist.

And yesterday we caught up with a man in the book of John Chapter 5. You know that man with that issue, that 38 years old case. And there was a lot that was said about it. In case you missed anything, I know is *that* long yesterday! We are not apologizing for that because we will not withhold anything that is profitable for you. And if you are making any resolution this year, is that you should give more, pay attention to things that are very important to you. You need to spend your data, you need to spend your time and find time for things. We are talking about your freedom here, we are talking about your liberty, we are talking about your benefits not somebody spoiling you out of it, cheating you or robbing you of it, we are talking about you even getting into it.

Like yesterday we are talking about contrasting two systems. **The old system in which you had to wait on somebody and you will be indebted and you cannot determine the probability and the new system in which you can take it now. As of Now!**

Now so before you run off with another thing this morning. I just want to draw you back to a verse in that John Chapter 5, where Christ was making an offer to him. You know it's too good that he cannot resist. And He was saying would you be made whole? You know Christ was not offering; was not putting something on the table and say would you just be able to walk? Would you want me to help you and push you to the river? Would you want me just make you to be able to walk? Would you just want me to stay or would you want me to just tell you the time that the angel will be visiting? But he gave an offer that's just too... "**Wholeness**" we are not just talking being healed. You know that is something I was looking to yesterday. Would you want to throw more light on that?

Thank you. Viewers all over the world. Thank you for joining us today again on Knock Out Series Four where've been looking at when is God visiting you and if you are just joining us today for the very first time, we've been trying to answer the question **does God has a set time to bless you?** It is a knock out series.

You know we think the church is at a time where we believe a lot of people have this wrong mentality that God has a particular season or God has set a particular time in which he is going to bless you and people trying to make sure they don't miss that time or that season.

The question we are trying to answer on knock out four **is it true that God has a set time to bless you?** Now your ability to answer the question goes a long way if you are going to walk in your destiny in Christ Jesus.

Yesterday we stopped at an instant of Jesus giving this man an invitation. What is quite amazing about Jesus invitation is, here was a man that was grabbling with an old system. The old system that this man was dealing with was a system that has to do wait for the troubling of the waters because the angel always come at a particular

season to trouble the waters. And this man hang his destiny on waiting for the season when the angel will show up.

And we came to that conclusion based on this event that this man actually also blamed that fact that there was no man to help him. And we did say yesterday that if you live by this old system you will always depend on the gifting and the anointing upon other people. That is why you have to be at every single meeting, make sure you don't miss every single convention or conference. Is good to be in meeting where you are sharpen by the Word. But if your reason for going to meeting all the time is just to make sure you don't miss your season. You are still living in the system that this man found himself.

And Jesus came to this man and gave him a different offering. Jesus invited this man into a different mentality. When Jesus Christ said do you want to be made whole? Jesus Christ was telling the man you know there is something you can do right now that can make you walk in that season? And that was the invitation Jesus gave this man.

And we did say yesterday Jesus is giving the same invitation to anybody who cares to listen and the invitation of Christ to this man is **would you be made whole?** That's what Jesus said would you be made whole?

Now and you see before we carry on let me say this, the reason why Jesus asked this man in John Chapter 5 if would you be made whole? Is because Jesus is simply saying do you know this all depends on your response. This is completely dependent on your response. If you response well, you can walk in your season now. Right away!

That is why the Church of Christ has to stop, I mean people walking in this wrong mentality or thinking that God has set a particular season and time in his calendar for him to bless you. If that was so, Jesus will not ask this man do you want to be made whole now? Do you want now? If you give me the right response you could get it now

and you see what we are talking about on this episode today is **how do we respond correctly? How do you as a Christian give the right response to make sure you can walk now in your season and in your timing?**

And you see you have to sit back and listen to what we have to bring by the grace of God on this episode today. So what Jesus spoke to this man in Chapter 5 of John in verse 7 if you read that,

The Bible says **the impotent answered him and said I have no man when the water to trouble to put me into the pool but while I am coming another step in.**

We've talked about this yesterday.

Now look at verse 8

Jesus said unto him

We are going to start from there. You are talking about being made whole and we are going to actually explore that.

And let's see what Jesus talked to this man first in verse 8 of John Chapter 5.

Please watch this statement of Jesus. If you listen to this statement of Jesus and give the right response you will walk now in your season. (In your wholeness)

Now if you don't give the right response you would actually go back to the old system of waiting for the troubling of the waters.

And if you were here yesterday and if you are not here, please listen to yesterday's episode we established the fact that if you walk by the old system of waiting for the move or the move of God through the meeting or the move of God through the minister of God, if you wait on that system. What will happen is you will walk on probability because this man confessed and said that if one person enters into the

water, that is it! Nobody else can get the healing they have to wait for the next season when the angel will come. And so many Christians live like that.

You see in a meeting where people give testimonies, if you work out the probability is just one out of hundred or one of out of a thousand or two out of a million or whatever that is the old system. Now Jesus spoke to this man and gave him an invitation. Please listen to how this man responded to the invitation of Christ.

Now Jesus said to this man, rise up take up your bed and walk (John 5:8)

Now viewers all over the world. Listen to this. If Jesus was going to tell a man who was an invalid. The Bible tells us this man was lame. If he is going to tell him to be healed, I thought what Jesus was going to say to this man is to say be healed. Or I give you healing, or I am saying that now let your legs be strong so that you can walk.

Now please Jesus did not say that. Look at what Jesus said. Now is important that we look at the response of this man. If we understand how this man responded to Jesus's invitation, it is an understanding of this kind of invitation that made us walk in our timing.

Jesus said to the man, I repeat **rise up now take up your bed and walk**. Amazing! Amazing because Jesus did not say be healed, Jesus did not say let your legs received strength. Jesus said rise up take up your bed and walk.

If you tell somebody to rise up and walk, it means the only reason why the person can rise up and walk is if the person understand that there is strength in their legs. If the person understand that they have the capacity in their legs, in their limb to walk. So for example if I go out there today and I tell a lame person who cannot walk, if I tell them rise up and walk, this lame person will look at me like am crazy, how can you tell me to rise up and walk when it is pretty obvious to you that am lame?

So the only reason why somebody can rise up and walk is because the person can see that they have the capacity to walk.

Now Jesus spoke to this man, he didn't say you are healed, watch the statement of Jesus. Jesus said **rise up and walk.**

So the only reason look at what happen

Look at verse nine (John 5:9)

Look at the response of this man in verse nine

“And immediately the man was made whole and he took up his bed and walked.”

Now listen viewers, the man took up his bed and walk because when Jesus told him to rise up and walk that means the man already accepted the reality that he has strength in his legs.

You will not rise up and walk if you believe you are still lame because you will tell the person asking you to walk that are they blind to see the fact that you are lame? So the reason the man acted in walking is because he accepted the fact that his legs has capacity to walk.

This is the simplicity of what faith is.

You see people teach faith in very strange ways and in very strange notions and in very strange ideas. People think that when we say you should have faith it simply means that, if you try to believe God and the thing you are believing God for then God can make it to happen. So if you believe God well enough you can make things happen in your life. That is not true!

This is the reality of faith. Is a man acting and actually carrying out what he believes he has received and is true. I will say it again. The reason why the man was able to rise up and walk is because he believes that there was strength in his legs. And this is what our response is all about.

You see every time God speaks the Word, every time God releases the Word into our life and we look at the perfect law of liberty, you see our response is what is called faith. In this 2017, are you going to act, are you going to communicate, are you going to reason like you can see that what God says is true about your life? That is what faith is.

Before we carry on there is something I want our viewers to understand that this man had been in this situation for thirty eight years. I will tell you the implication of that, every time you have been in the same situation for a length of time, what happens is, that situation will not just become a situation. It ends up becoming your identity. That is the why if you notice the woman with the issue of blood, she has no name in the Bible. The Bible says she is the woman with issue of blood. You know why? Because her situation, her circumstances has been there for that length of time that now she was known by the name of the disease that has taken hold of her life.

You see what happens to people is, when people has been in situations for a long time, the problem is not that they have the situation, is that the situation will have people. It means it encroaches into the mentality of people. It encroaches into the thought process of people. That is why if you notice if you are a student of the Bible and check the Bible very well, you will notice that there are times the scripture does not give us the name of some people. The scripture uses their circumstance or their situation to define who they are. That always happens if those people's identity has been connected to their circumstance.

Here was a man who was invalid for thirty- eight years. I don't know how long you have been believing God for something in your life. I don't know how long you've been in situation, I don't know how long you've been in that condition.

But listen one thing is even if the condition has taken over your identity and if you think about yourself. And in fact you are attaching yourself to that condition. In fact you think about yourself in view of that condition. That was the situation this man was. The Bible never gave us his name, it says there was a man, he was an invalid. That's just who he is. An invalid man, a man that has no capacity. But listen Jesus spoke to a man who had no capacity. Jesus spoke to a man who was an invalid. And Jesus said rise up. How can you tell someone who was an invalid? How can you tell someone who had no strength in their leg to rise up?

Now this is where the reality of the response of faith comes in. This is the reason we study the Word. You see the reason we study the Word is simply because we want the Word of God to show us the reality of who we are, because our flesh, our mindset our circumstance cannot unveil who we really are to ourselves. We would not know who we really are unless we look at the mirror of God's Word.

James Chapter One tells us the Word of God is the mirror that reflect the reality of who we are in our spirit (James 1:23-24). This is the reason we need to know who we are. The reason we need to know who we are is because in 2017 it is time to act, to rise up, to walk based on what we see that we are. This is the reason why so many people are waiting on God for a season because people are not seeing what God is seeing. When Jesus Christ told this man to rise up and walk. He could only say that because Jesus could see that he has strength in his legs. I say that again, Jesus only told him to rise up and walk because Jesus could see strength in his legs.

Now listen, what about if this man did not rise up? What about if this man said to Jesus, can you not see that am lame? Can you do something about the legs? Can you not make strength to come to my legs? Unless there is strength in my legs, I cannot rise up and walk. This is the reason why we always simply say faith is the response

from man. Your response is so critical. Can you act and think in 2017 believing that God has blessed you with all spiritual blessings available in Christ Jesus?

Can you think, can you make plan, can you strategize in 2017 knowing that what God said about you is true? Can you act that way? Can you talk that way? Can you communicate that way? This is where the whole problem is with so many Christians. We want to see before we can believe, but here was a man Jesus told him to rise and walk even though it was obvious he was lame. What did he do? He responded. The Bible says he stood up and he walked.

Now you see the problem that we do have then is, there is a kind of disconnection. We've said it before in previous series between when God says something rise up and walk. Because Jesus can see there was strength in his legs. When he said that, what happens is, when we receive such instruction, you see we begin to process it with our mind. The problem we have is our mind. That is why the Bible talks about our mind needs to be renewed. Our mind needs to come into agreement with what is in reality of our spirit.

Let me say this, our response is the key thing in the kingdom of God. Christ is in you, Christ lives in you. Completion lives in you. Wholeness lives in you. Healing lives in you. Perfection lives in you. Gentleness lives in you. Goodness lives in you. Everything you need for life and godliness lives in you. But unless you act accordingly. You see for example, we have said the reason why a Christian cannot live in sin is because he can see that you are righteous. If you see the way you are, you will act accordingly.

So here was a man who actually stood up and walk because he could see that there was strength in his legs. Can do you see that? So what do you see? That is a question. What do you see is what you are going to respond to? And what you respond to is what makes the power of God to flow in your life. So that's what we see about this man. And the Bible says something about him. He was made whole. And you see that

is very important. He was made whole, now the wholeness means completion. It means this wasn't just a matter of his legs.

That is why we talked about the fact that, the reason why this man acted on what Christ said is because his mind must have come into it, his thought process must have come into it. What happened to this man wasn't just a physical deliverance of his leg it was a completion of his life. He was made whole!

And you see what comes to heart is those ten lepers. You know, who came to Jesus and you see when they were healed, what happened? They all went away. And one of them came back and gave thanks and the Bible says he was made whole. (Luke 17:11-19) Now in that particular event we know that there is a difference between just getting healed and being made whole.

But you see we are saying this to you, when you walk with Christ's system. When you listen to the Words of Christ, when you respond to what Christ is saying what happens is your mind has to come into agreement with the Word. That is why the Bible talks about renewing our mind (Romans 12:2). Once your mind comes into agreement with the Word, there is a deliverance going on not just in your body, not just in your life, in circumstances, even in your soul, in your mind, in your thinking, in your reasoning there is a renewal going on. And the Bible says when that happened to you, is not just about you receiving deliverance to your circumstance, wholeness is coming into your life.

Now there is one thing I want us to look at John Chapter 9 as well regarding a similar situation.

For you to walk in your season you need to respond and act out the Word of God. If you are not acting out the Word, it means you don't believe the Word is true. If you believe the Word is true, you need to act out the Word.

John Chapter 9

Let's see a particular man who was in a similar situation to this man.

See what he says now this man was born blind and Jesus said something to this man.

Now verse six

Now this was a man who was born blind.

Look at John Chapter 9 verse 6 it says

John 9:6

6. "When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay.

7. And said unto him, Go wash in the pool of Siloam. (which is by interpretation, Sent) He went his way therefore and washed, and came seeing."

When he had thus spoken Jesus spat on the ground and make clay of the spittle.

Watch this!

And he said unto him, go watch in the pool of Siloam

Again! Again Jesus refused to tell the man you are healed. Now please can you begin to see the correlation of John Chapter 9 and John Chapter 5? Jesus did not tell this man you are healed now can you go and wash in the pool of Siloam. Jesus told this man to go and wash in the pool of Siloam even though there was no evidence that his eyes were opened. And this man went to the pool of Siloam.

Now see what the Bible says, the Bible says **he went his way therefore and wash and came back seeing.**

Now let's say this again this is why I repeat so many Christians are confuse about the notion of faith. You see if you read what the Word says about you, if you look at the perfect law of liberty James Chapter One and you see what the Word of God says about you. Do you respond to the Word? Do you act based on the fact that the Word is

true? If you are been believing God for anything and you know it has been given to you in Christ Jesus, what is your action? What is your response? Faith is not about trying to make God to do something for you. Faith is your response to the Word. This man walked to the pool of Siloam.

Now see what this man's commentary is about his own healing.

See what he said. This is very important.

See what the man said to them. Can you read verse 7?

And said unto him, Go wash in the pool of Siloam (Which is by interpretation, Sent) He went his way therefore and washed, and came seeing."

Look at verse 11

When the Jews asked the man to tell them what happened to him. See what the man said. The Bible says "he answered and said" am reading John Chapter 9 verse 11

John 9:11

"He answered and said, a man that is called Jesus made clay and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received my sight."

Now see what he said

"He said I went and wash and I received my sight."

I went -I acted on what he said. I washed - I acted on what Jesus said and I received my sight because I acted on what the Word of God says. For example the Word of God says in **1Peter 2:24 that by the stripes of Jesus ye were healed.** Now if you receive that Word and you study that Word and you have any condition in your body. If you have any medical situation in your system and the Bible didn't says by the

stripe of Jesus you are going to be healed. The Bible says by the stripes you were healed. And if you read that Word and you receive that Word as a reality of your life. You will start to talk, act, behave as somebody who knows that Word is true, who knows that Word is real. And that is what we are talking about. You will not begin to make plans and begin to make preparation for sickness, you will not start making preparation for disease. You will not start to say you know what, we don't know what is going to happen, I think we need to get ready just in case. That is why we did say, faith is all about our response. We don't make things to happen to God by faith. Things happen to us by faith.

Here was a man that Jesus did not tell him you are healed from your blindness. Jesus said Go wash in the pool of Siloam. You know the test of this man? If this man refuses to go and simply say well Jesus if it is true that I was healed of my blindness. Please let me see and am going to wash in the pool of Siloam. The reason this man walk all the way there and came back is because he believed what Jesus said to him as the reality.

And so let say this again and again, if you want to walk in your season. If you want to respond to the new system that Jesus Christ is bringing. In this new system, you cannot be lazy when it comes to seeing the reality of who you are in Christ Jesus through the Word. The Word of God reveals us to us.

The Word of God shows us who we are in Christ Jesus. And as soon as we see who we are in Christ Jesus, we have to start walking immediately. Start acting immediately, start behaving that way immediately, start to see things that way immediately, start to communicate that way immediately. That the Word that you've seen is true. Unless we walk by that system, we would be subject to the old system where we will start waiting for the troubling of the water.

And there is something I want us to look at today which is very important, about a system this invitation of Christ that makes a man to walk in his season straight away.

We are looking at the invitation of Christ that makes a man to walk in his season immediately.

We are going to look at this man in the book of Psalms.

You see this man in Psalms Chapter One.

Don't forget like we said, we are investigating this system that makes a man walk in his season straight away.

Now if you are there if you have your scripture, you can follow us with this, if not we are going to read from here.

Psalm chapter One.

Let's see what God has to say about this man who actually walks in his own season.

Psalm Chapter one...

Psalms 1:1-3

1. "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2. But his delights is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

3. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper."

Now I read from verse one. It says

Blessed is the man that does not walk in the counsel of the ungodly, now you see counsel there means ideology and don't forget if you are with us in the previous episode. We said in Colossians Chapter 2 from verse 8 to verse 16 if you follow wrong thinking, even if you are a Christian. The Bible says your wrong mentality, your wrong ideology can spoil you of your inheritance in Christ Jesus.

So the Bible is going to start with this man and tells us that one thing outstanding about this man in Psalm Chapter One is that this man does not take concept, ideologies that are ungodly. He does not subject himself to wrong counsel.

Now listen, it says he does not stand in the way of sinners. If you look at that again, when he says the man does not stand in the way of sinners. The word “ways” there mean, the method of doing things, you see your ideology, your perception of things, that is the reason why Psalm 103 tells us about the fact that the children of Israel all they know about God was the Acts of God. Can you see that?

The children of God lived by the Acts of God. But he says Moses knew the ways of God.

Now listen, again we see those two different two system being contrasted in Psalm 103.

You see some people all they know is to see the moves of God upon the waters. They want to see God trouble the waters. They are going to wait for their season for God to show up, perhaps God will have mercy on them. But some for some other people knows the way of God. They know the methods of God, they know the principles of God. They can make things happen by the way they respond to the Words of Christ. And listen in Psalm 103, he contrasted the children of Israel to Moses by saying some knew the Acts of God and that is all they knew-the troubling of the waters. But he says Moses knew God’s ways.

Here is says the blessed man in Psalm Chapter One does not stand in the ways of sinners.

This man has the right approach to things. He doesn’t stand in the ways of sinners. Watch it...

We said **ways** means what? Your approach to things, your perception of things, how you look at things. He said this man does not stand in the ways of sinners.

Look at the next thing

He does not sit in the seat of the scornful...

Now if you notice in Psalm Chapter One, **these three things talking about he does not walk in the counsels of the ungodly, he doesn't stand in the ways of sinners, he does not seat in the seat of the scornful.**

Those three things show us a man who is not walking by the wrong ideology. If you notice, again I repeat, you see a man that does not walk in the counsels... Counsels there does not mean the man is actually acting. It's just a concept, a way of doing things, the thinking pattern. So it tells us about the things that this man does not do.

Now watch!

The next one says

Verse two says

But his delight is in the law of the Lord, in that law he meditate day and night.

Now listen! It means then for those people who don't delight in the law of the Lord. For those Christians who don't take time out to labor in the Word, what it means is that we are given to counsels, we are given to different ways, we are given to being scornful.

Now you see the word scornful in verse One, it means when you despise Godly counsel.

Scornful itself is about ideology, is about the way of thinking in verse One of Psalms.

Now it says this man the reason why this man is not given to all these wrong concept and the wrong thinking patterns is because in verse two this man delights in the law of the Lord.

It means the only insurance you have against wrong thinking, against philosophies of men, the only insurance you have against the traditions of men is to delight yourself in the law of the Lord. Unless if you don't go to verse two, you end up back in verse one.

So the reality is this, if you want to be immune to men's traditions in 2017. If you want to be immune to counsels, to ways of doing things that are completely going to deprive of your benefits in Christ. You need to go on to verse two and delight yourself in the law of the Lord.

Now wait! It says in that law, he meditate day and night. It means then this is not what you are going to do for ten minutes or five minutes. That is why we said yesterday that John Chapter 8, verse 31 and 32. Jesus said to the Jews that believe in him, that if you continue in my Word. Can you see that? 'If you continue in my Word.'

The Bible says about this man in Psalm chapter One. The only reason why this man was immune to counsels, to ways of doing things that are depriving people of the benefits of the cross, is because this man just doesn't meditate on the Word. He mediated day and night. Consistency! Continuing in the Word is what immune this man against counsels and ideologies that are not beneficial to his destiny. Now he mediate on the Word day and night. That is the word! Day and night!

And you see verse three says

He shall be... Can you see that? Look at that.... This is very critical now

"This man shall be like the tree planted by the rivers of waters."

Now look at this

The next phrase is very important. Let's listen to that...

"He says he shall be like the tree planted by the rivers of water that brings forth his fruits in his season"

That is the Word!

Now listen!

Now let's look at this. If you do agriculture. This is pretty obvious out there. You will notice that every plants has its own season. Now the reasons the tree and plants have their season is because they depend on external supply for them to survive. For example, if there is no rain and if there is no moisture, if there is no oxygen, if there is

no carbon dioxide. If there are no supplies of nutrients. Plants will die off. That is the reason why in Fall you see that the plants shed their leaves. When it comes to Fall in Autumn the plant shed their leaves because the season is not favourable. Now the reason is plants depend on external factors for survival.

But the Bible says this man has change the game. This man in Psalm Chapter One has changed the system. What this man did in Psalm Chapter One, this man is like a tree planted by the rivers of waters.

This tree is not waiting for supply from the rain. This tree is not waiting for supply from the elements or the climate. This tree has already his fixed his root by the rivers of water. It means then, this tree can continually draw on the supply. That is why he says, he can bring forth his fruits in his own timing.

Now watch this!

Look at the next verse.

“It says his leaves shall not wither”

So are you saying there is no fall?

This tree is not waiting for when it is spring, this tree is saying do you know what, am going to have to shed my leaves in Autumn in the Fall. Because the weather is not too nice. Am going to wait until spring for me to spring up. Because you know what, am going to wait for the season to come up.

Now the Bible says this does not happen to this tree. Because this tree is continually supply, is planted by the rivers of water. This is what happen when you respond to the Christ life that is in you.

Now listen!

If you respond to the life of Christ in you, if you allow the Word of Christ to override your mind, if your mind is renew in the Word, the Bible says this man, he was meditating day and night. This man was meditating day and night. Now we know that

the Bible is comparing a man that is meditating on the Word day and night in the same way is like a tree that has fixed its root to constant supply.

Now it says this man can determine his own season

He says “**bring forth season in his own season.**” No you don’t bring forth fruits in your season normally you bring forth fruits in the season of the weather.

You bring forth fruits in the season of the climate. You wait for the troubling of the water as it were. Or you wait for the climate to be favorable. The Bible says No! This particular tree actually brings forth his own results in his own season. He determines it. He actually walks in his own season as he wishes. And that is why it tell us that his leaf doesn’t fall. It means if this plant say do you know what, I will continually be productive, there is no downtime. The Bible says it’s happening. This particular plant has no downtime! There is no downtime with it.

How did this happen? This doesn’t follow the laws we have in agriculture. The Bible says it will happen to you if you labor in the Word to meditate day and night to receive constant supply from the life of Christ that dwells in you.

And that is how this man in Psalm One walk in his own season. He walked in his own timing. He walked in his own moment by digging his root, deep down to the ground for constant supply of water to be taken on by this man.

So what we are simply saying is this, the Bible is simply contrasting this man in Psalm one and the Bible is contrasting and comparing at the same time. He says, this man’s life, the result of the life of this man is the same result a tree will get when he is in constant what? When it is constantly connected to the supply.

Now it means then, you and I don’t have to wait for the next moments of the move of the troubling of the waters. It means you and I, we don’t have to wait for the next conventions, you and I don’t have to wait for the man of God to release a special

Words into our lives at the next meeting. It means then you and I can decide to produce fruits and results in our season. Can you see that?

When it says our season, you would have thought that it was simply saying is *one off*.

But the next verse tells us in Psalm chapter one
That it so happens that his leaf don't wither.

Now I actually challenge you to show me a plant or a tree that doesn't respond to the weather. Trees respond to the climate. But Bible say it can so happen that you can bring forth results in your life as at when necessary by you constantly connected to supply. And Christ is your supply.

Christ in you is your supply

Christ in your spirit is the hope of glory. He's your supply. Dig down to that supply. In fact the Bible says with joy you would draw water from the well of salvation. You have to make a demand on the life of Christ in you. You have to dig your roots deep down. In Colossians 3 it tells us, it says let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly... he said being rooted in him.

Can you see that?

Can you dig your root deep down into Christ? He said, be rooted. It tells us how you can be rooted. His not ambiguous. This is not philosophy. We are not teaching Psychology here. The Bible says if you let the Words of Christ dwell in you. Mark the Word **richly**. You cannot do this in 5 or 10 minutes study or meditation. It said, allow **the Word to dwell in you richly**. Can you see that?

No wonder this man in Psalm one meditated day and night.

He said if you allow the Word of Christ to dwell in you richly. He said, you'll rooted and built up in him. This is how you can always walk in your season. No downtime for your life. It means then what the Bible said about the path of the just shining brighter and brighter until the perfect day. No downtime!

Have you ever notice some people they are wondering how can you be so blessed all the time? And they said you know, what the reason am so blessed now is maybe something bad might happen very soon. You see that? You know what I think my fruits are blossoming, my leaves are blossoming. We are in the spring now. Maybe at some times, my leaves will wither. The reason why people has those wrong ideology is simply because you have not become so confident in the fact that your roots is going down to the rivers of the living water. Your roots is going deep down.

The Bible gives you a guaranty. Listen to the heavenly insurance. The Bible says if your roots goes down to the rivers of living water. There will be a guaranty that your leaves will never wither. It means for you, you are not waiting on a season for you to blossom. You are not waiting for a declaration over your life. You are not waiting for the next year 31st of December for them to release the next word into your life.

And you see that is why you see people who are actually saying you know what I think I'll receive the word. Yesterday I know some Christians had gone to services-cross over services. What they say, you know, I want a word to be spoken into my life and I can carry that word for the next 365 days. I can be sure my life is guaranty.

And I see I remember yesterday we are talking about the Sabbath where God set up a system where God sent down the manna from heaven. And God has to subject them to season and timing for them to pick up the manna. You see what I notice is, God told them in Deuteronomy Chapter 8, Exodus 16, He told them that you see on the day before the Sabbath, make sure you gather enough so that tomorrow there will be nothing, so that you can have enough to sustain you all through. And that is what's happening to so many mentality. Wilderness mentality. The mentality that makes you carry a big bucket where you think you know what I think I need to gather all for the next 365 days or the 31st of December for I don't know what is going to happen when

the next season will show up in my life. That is the mentality that Christ came to get rid out of your thinking.

The Bible says you can so meditate on the Word day and night that your roots will be like that of a tree that is going down to the rives of living water getting constant supply in such a way that your leaves will never wither. Your leaves will never fall. You wonder how is it that is getting better and better? You are shining brighter and brighter. Yes it is possible if your leaves, if your roots goes down to supply. And the Bible says that happens if you meditate day and night on the Word.

So we've seen a system that works. Psalm Chapter One shows a man that was walking by the very same system that Christ actually brought to use in Redemption

Now let's carry on from there, which is what we have to clarify.

We go back again to Psalm chapter One, the one we just read.

I'll pick it from the verse.....

I think we did read verse three

“And you shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of waters that bringeth forth his fruits in his season. His leaf shall not wither.”

So what we've established, we've established the fact that this man can be in season all the time. Can you see that?

Now I think viewers can you listen to that? Here is a man that can be in season all the time. This man is in season all the time. His leaves doesn't wither.

What is the next thing?

“Whatsoever he doeth...”

Whatsoever this man does prosper. Is telling us why he believe this man will always be in season. Now I know people are going for prosperity meeting, breakthrough services where you can actually break forth to the next level.

Now listen the scripture says, this man is always going to prosper in whatever he does.

Now I understand some Christians believe the fact that prosperity teaching and prosperity gospel is not a true gospel. Well let's say this quickly, it doesn't matter how you interpret prosperity to be, I know the Bible says in the book of Isaiah he said **no weapon fashioned against you shall prosper** (Isaiah 54:17). But of course, is not saying the weapon will have money or no money.

The fact is I don't care how much you interpret prosperity to be, but one thing we should all agree about in terms of prosperity is, the reason why he says the weapon shall not prosper is that, the weapon will not achieve his purpose, the weapon will not achieve his target. Now the fact is we at least must agree that prosperity is about you hitting your target in destiny. That prosperity is at least you hitting the very reason why you are created.

The Bible says you can always prosper in whatever you do. You will not always be waiting for a season to prosper. You will not wait for the next (like I said) declaration to prosper. Waiting on a man, you will not wait on the next prosperity service to prosperity. Because now we have prosperity meetings and prosperity services. There is nothing wrong with prosperity services.

But the Bible says this man is not waiting for the next prosperity meeting. This man is prospering in all he does. But don't forget he said this man leaf does not wither. It's amazing we have a man who is not waiting for a season. Because the man himself is perpetually in season. His leaf is not falling off, his leaves is not withering. This man is perpetually in season.

So if you there listening to this, and you are wondering and somebody told you now is getting good for you, when will you get the evil part like Job said, can a man receive good and not get evil from God? That is the thought of Job.

And may I say this to you viewers all over the world. Now for every words in the Bible they are not the Words of God. The words of Satan are in the Bible, the words of men are in the Bible and the Words of God are in the Bible. That is why the Bible say in 2Timothy 2:15 that you need to rightly divide the Word of God. It was Job that said can a man get good and not evil from God.

Now listen the Bible says this man in Psalm Chapter One is perpetually in season. Now we are answering the questions we've been asking all this while, that **does God has a set time to bless you? When is God visiting you?**

Now the reality is, the Bible says in Psalm Chapter One is perpetually in visitation. This man in psalm chapter one is living in visitation perpetually. How did I know that? The Bible says its leaf does not wither. His leaves never falls off. Never falls off... he didn't waiting for a visitation. He lives perpetually in visitation. How did he do that? How did this man achieve that feat? How did he do it? The Bible said all he did was to dig his roots in supply.

And how did he do that?

Back up to verse two, he says all he did was to continually look at the law of liberty, all he did was to continually see himself the way heavens see him. All he has to do was to act, think and reason how God sees him.

And you see let me say this for those that believe in prayers. We believe in prayers and I believe as a Christian if you are listening to this, you must be a fanatic. I will say why I said that. Some people when they switch to this channel and they are looking at..., they just say well what are they talking about? They just flip away and I believe if you are listening to this, and you are taking time out not to scroll to the next page on your Facebook. It means you must be a fanatical Christians. If that's true let's talk about this. It means you believe in prayer. If you believe in prayer you would want to

listen to this. You will want to listen to this because the Bible says God is able to do listen exceedingly abundantly more than we could ask or think. (Ephesians 3:20)

Now listen when we talked about prayer we believe in asking God in petitioning the Father. But the Bible says what God does in you finally is not just all about what you are asking, is so about what you are thinking. Can you see that?

So what you get from God eventually in the place of prayers is not just limited to your asking, is also to your thinking. I repeat that verse, is in Ephesians. It says “God who is able to do exceedingly abundantly more and above than what you can ask or think.” So if you are believing God for a visitation and your are thinking, if your thinking is in the dust, if your thinking is thinking like a man who believes that they have to scream and shouts and hope that God will favour them, if God will wishes so, if your thinking is that, it means your thinking is running in contrary to the reality of what God has done for you in Christ Jesus. Because in Christ Jesus the visitation of God is in you already.

Christ is God’s visitation.

In fact Romans Chapter 5 verse 1 and 2 tells us by whom we have access into this grace, he is saying by Christ Jesus we have access into that grace. We have that visitation perpetually. It mean if you have Christ in you, you have access into that grace. You are not hoping for access, you are not begging for access. It says you have access through Christ Jesus, it says by whom we have access. If that is the reality, if you think less than that, if you are not thinking that way, the Bible says what we get from God eventually is limited to how we think. That is why he says you will get exceedingly abundantly more than what you are asking or thinking. That is why this man is a smart man.

This is a smart man in Psalm Chapter One. This man makes sure he meditated upon the Word day and night to get the picture of how God sees him.

Then you might want to ask me a questions if you are there, **why do I need to meditate in the Word day and night? Why is that critical?** Now the answer is simple, the reason is you see, your spirit man, what God did for you in Christ Jesus is not obvious to your body. Is not obvious to your mind. Your mind has no idea what happens in your spirit man at Redemption. Your mind has no idea.

For example, if you look at your face, if I ask you to tell me what is in your forehead? You'll have no idea if there is anything, something like a paint, or like a dust or something you'll have no idea what is in your forehead unless you get a mirror to look at it so you can see how you look at.

The Bible says in James Chapter One that the Word of God is the mirror of our spirit. So the Word of God is what reveals to us, is what tells us how we look like in our spirit man and that is why have to meditate on the Word day and night so that we can keep seeing how God see us. And the Bible says if we can see ourselves how God see us we are going to act accordingly.

That is why when Jesus spoke to the man in John Chapter 5 and Chapter 9, Jesus told the man in Chapter 5 rise up and walk. Jesus said that to him because he expect the man to see himself that his legs were strong.

He told the man in John Chapter 9 go and wash in the pool of Siloam and you see the man said I wash and I came back seeing. You see this man acted based on what he could see of what Christ said to him.

That is why unless you meditate on the Word, unless you can see your picture in the Word, unless you can see the Word in you. You will not act accordingly. Unless you act accordingly you will not give the right response to the Word. And if you don't give the right response to the Word it means you are not walking in faith. And that is the reality of what happens to this man in Psalm Chapter One.

Yeah I will like to challenge our viewers to be like that man, be like the man in Psalm One. Be like that man in John Chapter 5, be like that man in John Chapter 9. Because they own up their responsibility, they own up their healing, that they make it their own. They own their healing themselves.

You know that John Chapter 9 was saying I went, I wash and I came back seeing. So he owns it on. So you need to own up your destiny this year and you need to own it up not attach and so shunt the queue change the game. You know you can determine your season like in Psalm One, like John Chapter 5 the man lives in season perpetually his leaves never wither.

Like in Psalm One, like in John Chapter 5, like in John Chapter 9 like those lepers, you know like that lepers, they own it up. They own up their healing because it was for them they said they were not healing before. It was for them they say go and show up yourself to the priest. You don't go to the priest unless you are healed. They take control of the healing themselves. That is what we are challenging you to take control of your healing, take control of your miracle and not be dependent on a man. And not be dependent on a system on a programme. You know you have to shunt the queue.

This is a new system that is why if you notice Psalm Chapter One told us what the man actually... in verse one he told us what the man refuses to do. He refused to follow wrong mentality, wrong counsels, wrong way of thinking, wrong arrangement. He refuses that and in verse two can you see that, he found a better offer. He was smarter.

And I think then there is something we are talking about now, we did say it yesterday for our viewers who listen to us. What we said yesterday is, is apparent the reason why some Christians are not willing to follow this system we are talking about is because you are still embracing the old system. You see, well we might call it the old

system or else you might not even call it the old system. Is a system that is still at work. But the system that is at work is a system in which God, is a wilderness system where God has chosen to bless people believing that we will take that time to learn to grow.

That is why we repeat, we say this again, Deuteronomy Chapter 8 verse one, God said I let you through the wilderness and I fed you with manna, I had to make you wait on my timing and on my season to draw you food. God said I did that so that you can take time to learn, you can use that opportunity to learn that men will not live by bread alone. It means the reason why God blesses us in which He gives us timing and season in which He does that so that we can have the opportunity not to die before we learn the Word.

But unfortunately some Christian have decided to use that as a main stay of receiving from God. And if you do that, if you listen to our yesterday episode, we've talked about the consequences of taking that system.

So the Bible tells us about this man in Psalm Chapter One that he shunt the old system in chapter one and move to the new system in verse 2.

And I think before we leave today, there is something we really need to talk about when it comes to God's seasons and time.

Oh I think is time! Yeah I think viewers is better for us to leave this with the viewers before we actually round up today and I think that is very important because people asked questions about the timing and seasons of God to bless us or to do something in our lives and in our generations.

You see there is something that comes to heart and this is about Christ Jesus. We might not actually open all these verses, we will talk about them so that viewers can go and read them.

You see Galatians Chapter 4 verse 4 tells us Jesus Christ was born in due season.

Am going to read what it says, we need to read it so that viewers can actually understand what we are actually talking about.

See Galatians Chapter 4 verse 4

Now I read from verse 3

Galatian 4: 3-4

This is understanding how God's timing and season works and how we can work in that timing and season. We are looking at different perspective

Look at verse 3 what does it says?

Galatians 4:3-4

“Even so we, when we are children were in bondage under the elements of this world. But when the fullness of the time was come.”

Yeah it says we are in bondage, we are in captivity but when the fullness of the time was come.

God sent forth his son, Jesus when the fullness of time was come.

Now you see and I think because of kind of verses, this kind of scriptures is why some Christians are saying like Job said I will wait until my appointed time and I think I cannot really count how many times I have seen conventions and conferences that says you are my appointed time- Title of the convention. This is your appointed time, or appointed season. People use that quoting job as back up and all that!

People quote all that waiting for the move of God. Now before you carry on with that revelation now lest see what the Bible has to say about how does God time actually come. I mean how does the appointed time show up in your destiny?

Now look at what the Bible says in Galatian 4:4 it says when the fullness of time was come, God sent forth his son which is good. What we are thinking is, it means that God was waiting in the heavens and God was waiting for maybe 2000 years before God actually sent forth his son Jesus. That is what you think on the surface. But a careful study of the scripture brings up something contrast.

How did I know that? Now if you take time to read chapter 2, it talks about two people in Luke Chapter 2. Now in Luke Chapter 2 I think we need to read this so that our viewers can get the full revelation.

Luke Chapter two see what it says about the birth of Jesus.

Please can you read Luke Chapter 2 verse 25?

Now don't forget Galatians 4:4 said Jesus was actually shown up in the flesh at the fullness of time. Let's see how the fullness of time came.

“And behold there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simon and the same man was just and devout waiting for the consolation of Israel and the Holy Ghost was upon him.”

So there was a man that was waiting, there was a man as you may call it, the bridegroom in waiting, there was a man that was waiting for the consolation of Israel. And it was reveal unto him by the Holy Ghost that he should not see death before he had seen the Lord Christ. That is good.

Now the God told this man that see, wait you will not see death until you have seen the Lord Christ., until Christ shows up. It means there was a man waiting, there was a man waiting for Christ to show up on the scene.

Now you might be wondering was this man just waiting and folding his hands and say you know what I am going to wait until Christ shows up. Was Simon hanging around and waiting?

Let's see what the Bible has to say

If you go on to verse 34

“And Simon bless them and said unto Mary his mother, behold this child is set forth for the fall and rising of many in Israel and for a sign which shall be spoken of.”

This was Simon in verse 34 prophesying about the baby Jesus. Now go on to verse 36
Now don't forget we've left Simon we are on to somebody else in verse 36.

36. “And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity,

37. And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day.”

This is another person, Anna a prophetess.

Please listen it means even though we know that the Bible says Jesus was shown up at the fullness of time, at the fullness of time he showed up. However we now know there were some people who were actually right there praying and doing what they should do putting all the conditions right for the fullness of time to show up. Anytime the Bible talks about fullness of time, it happens when people actually do what they should do, when all things come together. The right conditions are met.

Now listen even for example when God gave a prophecy about the fact the children of sail from the land of Egypt, the Bible says until the cup of the gentiles will full. It means at the time that Israel will be taken out of captivity was when the cup of the Amorites was actually full.

In reality the season and the timing of God in your life is dependent on your response. If Anna daughter of Phanuel, if men like Simon were not prophetically waiting for Jesus to stand in their place that timing might never show up.

Now for example, they asked Jesus one questions about timing. They asked Jesus when will the end come in Mathew 24? I mean the disciples asked Jesus when will the

end come? Is in the book of Mark as well. When will the end show up? And you know what Jesus said to them, Jesus said to them that even no one knows the timing, no one knows the season that the end shall come except my Father in heaven.

And when Jesus made that kind of statement, now the questions am wondering is oh that is fine, we don't know what timing that Christ will show up. We see what it says in Mathew 24. In Mathew 24 Jesus then told us. Read it please.

Don't forget Jesus said nobody knows the timing and the season that He's going to actually show up. The second coming of Christ when the end will come. That is what Jesus Christ said.

Now let's listen to this.

In Mathew 24, let's look at verse 14

“And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.”

And this gospel shall be preached in all the world.

Now watch this! The gospel shall be preached in all the world. Now

For a witness to all nations, and then shall the end come

But I thought they said he couldn't know the time.

So?

It means the *kairos* of God- God's season and timing. Jesus said when the gospel of the kingdom shall be preached as a witness to all men, then the end shall come.

It means then even as we are ministering now, as we are preaching the gospel now, can you see many years ago in the past. The gospel was very hard to penetrate the Middle East. Can you see that?

Now as we are on the Expose for as many people are actually listening to this, for the penetration of the gospel through technology.

Can you see the advent of technology has made Mathew 24 more probable.

Now I say it again, it means if you are waiting and saying when will Christ shows up? When is the second coming of Christ? When will the end come? The Bible says even though he says nobody knows the timing, but you have to interpret that in view of other scriptures. He is simply saying that because there are conditions that must be met. And once those conditions are actually met then the season come into force.

Now listen the Bible says when all men, when the gospel of the kingdom is preach as a witness to all nations then the end shall come. It means then because of the advent of technology as we are talking at the moment. The gospel of the kingdom is penetrating places it could never have reach before in the past.

It means then the Bibles says if the gospel of the kingdom reaches all the nations and ends of the earth then the end shall come. It means that God's timing and season works in life, in this situations based on people connecting to the conditions and that is why Peter says 2Peter 3

“hastening the day of the coming of the Lord” (2Peter3:12)

If it is not possible to speed up the day of his coming, it means as we are ministering the gospel as we are doing now, we are hastening, we are speeding up the coming of Christ. While are we doing that? Because we are actually ensuring the gospel of the kingdom gets to the end of the earth.

It means then if men give the right response they can activate the season of God. That is what we are talking about in their life. It means we can actually activate. So if you are there, if you are unbelievers and you are listening to this and you are wondering when is Christ going to show up, when is the coming of Christ? They've been talking about this that Jesus Christ is going to come back soon. Nobody knows the time. It is true nobody knows the time, but the activation of that season, the activation of that timing is dependent on the response of man because the Bible says we can hasten the

day of the coming of Jesus. And the Bible says when the gospel of the kingdom is preach to the ends the earth then the end shall come.

What are talking about? We are simply saying if we give the right response to God, we can walk in our season now, and that is what we saw in the man of Psalm Chapter One. A man who walk perpetually in season.

So today we hope we've been able to fully answer that question when is God visiting? And so we are challenging you this year to be smarter. You know change the game, shunt the queue, determine the season. And be like that Psalm One man, be in season all the time. Be in your prime life all the time.

And so if this blesses you, you might need to go back again and watch this again. You know you have to continue just as in John Chapter 8, continue in this Word we see in Psalm One, being rooted in this and share it with your contacts because we really want people around you to be in the same shape that you are in.
