Doing That Which Was Done

Today is another day and we are glad that we are in. So we want to welcome you again to another transmission of Expose 247. If you are with us yesterday, we shared about the Done Deal. I want to assume you've done that. I want to assume that you've sent across your questions, your comments and things that needed clarification and you have shared this with your contacts.

So today can you just warm up as we delve further into this, the Lord's prayer in the book of Matthew Chapter 6. Would you want to summarize for those people who might have missed it or somebody who just need to jog their memory of what we shared yesterday?

Thank you viewers again for tuning in unto this Knock Out series on prayer. Like she actually said, we are actually at the moment exploring the Matthew 6 verse 10, where Jesus talked about the disciples praying that the will of God be done on the earth as it is in heaven. We began to look at the implication of that statement especially for you that you are under the New Covenant in the blood of Jesus.

As a matter of summary, in our last transmission, we came to a conclusion in 1John 5:14, where Bible says that unless we pray according to the will of God, we would not have any confidence to know that God hears our prayer. And he says if we know that God hears us, then we know we received the petition we asked from the Father.

So the point is, this issue of the will of the God is not a minor issue. It is a central matter. And then before we go on today, on what we are looking at today on this same matter. Let's us say that what does it mean to pray according to the will of God? We made that conclusion and say well, it means that you are asking in accordance to what was written in 1John Chapter 5 from verse 10 to verse 13, before the verse 14.

Now, we did say this last time, but we didn't actually have enough time to actually break it down. So we will do that quickly now, before we go on with today's transmission.

Now, it will mean that for you to ask according to the will, is in line with the fact that he said we know that God has given us eternal life. It means do you know all the things that go with that life? Do you know all the things that accommodate that life? If that life is present, there are things it supposes to manifest in your life. He says when you are asking anything, ask in accordance with that understanding. Ask in

accordance with that revelation, on that basis. That is what it means to ask in accordance to the will.

So we cannot disconnect 1John 5:14 from all the previous verses that you have there. And then using a similar example, using a practical example of somebody. I will give an example of a son that has a father. If the father actually put everything in his name. It doesn't necessarily mean that the father will transfer everything to his bank account. What the father does is, he writes a will and writes the will in the name of his son or his daughter. But when the father dies, and he is no more, you know according to Hebrews Chapter 9, he says the will does not go into effect until the death of the person who made the will, the testator. So if the father dies in the natural. Now everything the father has becomes that of the son because the Father wrote a will for the benefit of the son.

Now, if the son was going to ask anything, if he was going to probably go to the people who are the ones supposed to effect that will, it could be the father's friends, or some solicitors. The son can only ask as it were anything based on the understanding that the father left everything for him. He has to request on that basis. If he request outside that basis, it is pointless. He must ask or make a demand that they should give him what belongs to him on the basis that he knows everything was for his benefit. The father's credited him before he died.

So 1John 5 verse 10 to verse 14 reminds you and I that if you are going to ask anything at all, don't waste your time in prayer, you must ask in accordance with his will. And verse 10 to verse 13 tells us that we should first understand that God has given us eternal life. You have to first know. You have to come with that kind of tenacity, that kind of boldness. That is what it means to ask in accordance to God's will. It's got nothing to do with you saying Father should I eat rice or should I wear red tie? That is what people have actually relegated the will of God to. And it is a shame we have actually the power out of that revelation.

So this is what it means. If you are going to ask, you must ask in accordance with his will. And what is his will? That you know that God has given you all that you need for life and godliness.

I don't know what you are desiring from God today. I don't know what you are believing the Lord for. I don't know what you are making demand on the Lord for in the place of prayer. Ask according to his will. Not because you have an option, you don't even have an option. Bible says if you don't ask according to his will, God can't even hear what you are talking about. I think that is mind boggling. He said if we know we asked according to his will, then we know we are on the same frequency as

God. We know hears us. I don't think anybody wants to go to church, or you are in your room you want to pray or gather with the saints and the Bible is saying everything you are saying God can't even hear what you are saying. You know why? because you and God are not on the same frequency. We didn't say this. 1John 5:14 says if you want to know God is hearing you, you must be asking in accordance with his will. So this matter we are dealing with, is so significant, that is how critical it is.

Now, follow us quickly as we explore further on this dimension of why Jesus mentioned the will of God being done in the Lord's prayer? Why is it very critical for your prayer life?

Follow us quickly as we go to Romans Chapter 12 so that we can trust the Lord to shed more light on this insight for our prayer life.

Romans Chapter 12, you can please read verse 1 and verse 2. We are still on this matter of the will of the God being done on the earth as it is in heaven.

Romans 12

1. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Yes, so that means there are reasonable services.

2. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable, and perfect will of God.

Now, the reason we've come to this. You know if you listen to our last transmission by the word of God and the spirit of grace, what we find on the pages of the scriptures is that Jesus said He came to get the will done. We looked at Luke 22. We looked at Hebrews Chapter 9. We looked at other verses of the Bible in which Jesus emphatically said if we are talking about the will of God, I have come to do it already. I got it done.

And then, that then raises a question, where is the place of the believer concerning the will of God? What are you going to do with the will of God, if Jesus said he has actually come to do it, the will of the Father?

Now, here is the first verse we are seeing today. The Bible is saying in that verse 2 that there is something you need to do to prove the will of God.

Now read verse 2, and says

be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed

Now, the word transform there is the Greek word *metamorphoo* which means to be changed from one level to the next, from one glory to the next glory. He says be ye transformed.

Now, see what he says

by the renewing of your mind.

You know this is quite amazing, for the fact that the Bible says if anybody is in Christ, he is a new creation. And you will think if somebody is a new creation, why then do they still need transformation? since they are already in Christ. You don't need to have your mind renewed to be a new creation in Christ Jesus. All you need to have your mind renewed is to be in Christ. And to be in Christ, to be joined with the Lord, one spirit with the Lord. To receive the spirit of Christ into you.

And then so, even though you are a new creation, you know what? The world cannot see that you are a new creation. Your friends cannot see that you are a new creation. On your business, they cannot see your newly recreated spirit. They can't see it. Because Jesus said the world does not recognize him and He says because of that the world will not recognize you. They don't see it. You are a new creation. Blessed be the name of the Lord, that all of life of Christ is in you. Blessed be God. But nobody can see it. Even you yourself you can't even see it as well, because it is in your spirit.

But see what he says? He says if you want a transformation, can you see? Why a transformation? See the verse that came before that.

Be not conformed to this world...

Blessed be God he mentioned the word world. How does this world see things? This world only works at the level in which he can touch, feel, taste and see things. The world doesn't understand the spirit. Can you see that?

He says

Do not be conformed to this world.

And he says

Be ye renewed by the transforming of your mind.

It will mean then that he's asking us to do or he is asking something to happen to the believer that the world can recognize. Can you see?

Do not be conformed to this world. But be ye transformed.

Something that the world can say yes, we can see that person is changed. We can see that person is a new person. So he says for that to ever happen, you need to have your mind renewed. That is the only way the world at the moment can identify that you are a Christian. Your mind needs to be renewed. What does that mean? It means your mind needs to come to a conscious understanding of what already happened in your spirit man.

So let's say this so that we don't get it mixed up. Your renewal of your mind, doesn't make you a new creation. The renewal of your mind only brings an outward manifestation in your life that the world can recognize. That is what we see there. That is why for a Christian, mind renewal is not an option. If you don't renew your mind, you can live and die with a new life of Christ in you, but the world doesn't recognize anything about your life. So that is why he talks about transformation when he mentioned the world. Can you see that?

Now, look at this, this is where we are actually looking at this.

He says,

that ye may prove.

Now he is saying unless a Christian's mind is renewed, that Christian will not be able to prove. That Christian will not have the tools to be able to prove. So being a Christian or being born again or claiming to be a new person in Christ Jesus doesn't make you prove these things. It takes the renewing of the mind before you can prove what? Now look at this, the good, acceptable and perfect will of God.

You know somebody ask a question on one of our pages, a little while ago and the person is saying how can they tell the difference between the good will of God, the acceptable will of God, and the perfect will of God? And I know books have been written where people says there are three types of will of God. I want the perfect will of God. I don't want the good will or acceptable one. I want the one that is perfect. I know people do all these things.

In fact when people says all that, without even too much ado, just by simple grammatical reasoning. Have you noticed, he did not say the good, acceptable or perfect will of God. I don't know when people read that, they tend to put or there not and. They seem to say well, there are three types of will, choose which one you want to go for. The Apostle Paul did not say good, acceptable or perfect will of God. He says this will of God is good, acceptable and perfect. He used the word and, he didn't used the word or.

So please don't read or into where the Bible puts and. He just say that will is all three. That will of God is into all those three. That is what he is saying. There is no or is **anand** thing. I think that should answer that person's question. There are no three different category of God's will. If they were there will be **anor** here not and.

That being said. He said you as a believer, your responsibility is not to pray for the will to be done. Your responsibility is to prove it. Can you see? It's to prove that will. You are supposed to prove the will. That is why we said last time, if Jesus said he has come to do the will (Hebrews 9, Luke 22) what is your job? You prove it. You prove the will of God.

And then what is the proof there? It means demonstrate it. It means show it. You see the word prove here, if you do a bit of Greek is the word **dokimázō** in Greek. What does it mean? If you say **dokimázō** to a Greek person... don't forget the fact that we are not just trying to do Greek scholastic here, trying to show that we know some bit of Greek or Hebrew, far from that. That is not what we are trying to do.

We are just trying to say because the Bible, the New Testament specifically was originally writing in the Greek language. Don't forget that King James, whether NLT or New International version, all of them are to translate into English what was originally in the Greek. The reason why atimes is good for you as a Christian not to leave this Greek things to the "scholars" or why you should also a bit take some responsibility to check the root words in the Bible before they got it translated to English, so you can get deeper meaning of words.

You see the word **dokimázō** in Greek, if you tell a Greek person **dokimázō**, what it means to them is the word approval. To approve something. You know for those who works in Government institutions or in businesses, large companies or even small companies. There are times when you have projects or you have some things that want to be done. And you put these things right in front of the Boss, the employer or the manager.

You know even those things are already within the organization, there are plans that want to be executed, unless these things received approval, they don't go on to the next stage. Nobody see them as an executed project from the outside. Even though in the inside, it could have been done and dusted. In the inside the plans could have been completed, but before those outside the company can see what the company has decided internally, somebody needs to make a final approval so that the things can go beyond the company and people can see that such a company is executing such project.

The Bible says you as a Christian, you have the power. You have so much power in your hands that you are the one responsible for approving or proving the will of God that has been done anyway. It means he is saying that your mind, the renewal of your mind has the capacity to demonstrate to people, to approve as it were or to prove so people can see what has been done. Can you see? That is how we prove the will of God.

How did I know this? Because he already told you in the previous verse, that get your mind renewed so that you can be transformed. Somebody needs to see that Christ has dominion over sin. People don't know that. If you say that you have the grace of God in your life, the Bible says for sins shall have no more dominion over you, for you are no more under law but under grace. How can people see that? How can your friends see that? How can somebody in your environment know that grace give people dominion over sin? They have no idea about that. You have received the grace. The will of God has been done. See! Not will be done. But God says am waiting for people to approve it. Am waiting for people to prove it to the world. Am waiting for people to demonstrate it.

So what we do with the will of God that has been done is we are demonstrators or we are like a manager in a company who approve or who proves it, who shows it. So everything we do in the place of prayer, that is why when we come to the place of prayer, you need to know what you do in prayer is to prove the will of God. And who needs the approval? You are not the one that need the approval. It is the world that needs the approval.

That is why if you noticed in verse 2, he says don't be conformed to this world. Don't agree with the world system. But you have to show them something that you have been transformed. And how do you do that? You need to prove the will of God. And how do you prove the will of God? Your mind. Your mind is the problem. Your mind needs to agree with everything the Bible says is done. Even in your body, if you are not feeling great in your body, if you have any diseases in your body, your mind needs to be renewed to agree with 1Peter 2:24. You have to keep tuning your mind.

The Bible says you don't have a choice. You have to keep tuning your mind to the Word. He says why? You have a responsibility. You have a job. The job is cut out for you to prove and to approve, and demonstrate the will that has been done to the world to see. And if they see that, they can see you are transformed. And that is what we are supposed to start doing with the will of God that has been done. It means we have to start doing that which has been done. That is the word. We are doing and showing

what has been done. And that is what a Christian is meant to start doing with the will of God.

Thank you for that insight. I think our viewers, I hope they could hear us loud and clear that sometimes we don't need to engage our self in some needless prayer rituals or praying some points that is just needless in the New Testament. You know the word, am using the word needless in the light of the understanding of what the New Testament, of things that's already done and already established. And people are just want to pray down the spirit. It is our job, it is already cut out for us to really understand what the will of the Lord is. We cannot substitute the understanding, the studying of these things, gaining the knowledge about all these things by prayer. So we cannot substitute our understanding of what is being done, this will that is being done, with just trying to... we want to pray it out. But we should understand, not that we want to pray down what is already established.

We still see some prayer points today, people are still praying the Spirit down. Holy Spirit come down. The spirit has already been given. If you have...just like 1John was able to clarify do you have the Son? Then you have the life. You don't have the Son, you don't have the life. Is just exact. Is more than exact science here because as long as you have the Son you have life. It has just been simplified like that.

And our job is just to be a demonstrator. Just like 1Peter 2 was telling us that we are a chosen generation, royal priesthood. Those are the will. So that is what you need to know to understand and you are to show forth. You need to prove it. Approve it to the world. You have to show that you've being translated. That is the thing. That is the job. To know that you are... so you cannot be praying to be accepted, to be a priest again. You see some people now, they are praying to be priest. They want the royalty. You are already royal, you are a holy nation. People are praying to be holy. 1Peter says you are already but you are to show forth.

So your job is not about to be, somebody has done that for you and that part is settled. It is a done deal. The will of God has been by Jesus. If you listen to our last episode, it was a done deal. Those aspects was done and dusted.

So the B part of that 1Peter 2 verse 9 which am sure you know it, is that you are to show forth that you've being translated. So you have to prove and demonstrate that you have been translated. We are God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus unto good works. You know we have it in us, we have the nature of God in us. So you just have to show it forth. And that is what we are called to do. We are demonstrators. And that is our job. We have a specific job, title and assignment. So we just have to stay

within the bandwidth of our job description. We don't want to go beyond our pay grade.

Thank you for that insight.

Now, if you are wondering can we please tell you then, what is it then? How do you approve? How do we prove? You know I keep using the word approve because I say the original Greek word is the word **dokimázō**. It means you are like a Manager, God's file in your table, is in your spirit man. That is the word. Yourspirit man like a table. God is saying the will of God is waiting for you to approve so it can go through to the other side. So that people can see it. So that the world can see that it is true that you have a joy of the Holy Ghost. The world can't see that. They don't know that the Bible says that kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost. The world cannot see that. It is in your spirit. But who cares? They can't see anything. All they see some Christians do is depression, loneliness. They see Christians and the world is wondering is that what is in Christ?

And the Bible says God's file is in your table waiting for approval. He says prove it. And then how do you do that? There is no dark saying about it.

He says **be ye transformed by...**

He tells us the procedure, there is nothing dark about it.

By the renewal of your mind.

He says well, it means all you have to do then is, carry the scriptures, this is a practical example of Joy. And the Bible says the kingdom of God that is in you is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost. You read that. The Bible says in Galatians, he says the fruits of the spirit is love, joy.... so you see how mind renewal works. See how it works in practical terms. You read that. Oh! So it means the fruits of my spirit, this newly recreated spirit, the spirit of Christ in me...so it has joy, it has peace.

If you know what you have... Bible says as your mind begin to agree with what is the reality of your spirit, he says you will be getting transformed. And he says in the process you will be proving, you will be approving, you will be demonstrating what is the will of God.

Can you see then how a child of God, how a Christian... people say I want to walk in the will of God for my life. Have you ever heard people say that? Even if you are listening to this and you have said that before. I don't know if you know what you are

saying. But if you are saying you want to walk in a will of God for your life, this is it. This is how to prove it. How to walk in God's will. It's not exactly as we think it is.

So here he is saying that unless a Christian's mind is renewed, this mind renewing game is going to continue until you see Christ. The Bible says **receiving the end of your faith which is the salvation of your soul**. That is your mind, your will, your emotions. This is going to continue till Christ shows up in the flesh to take us home. So you have to understand that as far as you renew your mind, so far are you able to prove or approve the done will of God in your life.

So it means, in summary your spirit man is the bag of the done will of God. It's a container of the will that has been done. Christ has actually put his allotment, inheritance of God is in you. That is why the Bible says in Galatians that we are joint heirs with Christ. We are heirs of the Father. If we are heirs of the Father, it means the inheritance is in the saints. I like the place in Ephesians Chapter 1 where he says **that the eyes of your understanding be opened, that you will be flooded with light so that you may know the hope of his calling** and he goes on to say **the inheritance in the saints**. There are things, allotment in the saints(Ephesians 1:18).

But please the world needs a demonstration. The world needs somebody to prove that will. It's the will of the Father. He is giving us inheritance. But the world doesn't understand that. The world needs demonstration. The world needs an approval. Somebody needs to approve it and make the world to see. And the Bible says if you want to do that, your only way to ever do that is getting your renewed mind. And what is your renewed mind? Is where you thought process, your thinking pattern agrees with reality of what the Word of God calls you in Christ Jesus. That is a big business for a Christian to engage in.

Yes, peace and joy is just like any other reality of who you are. You cannot just allow it gather dust. You cannot just keep these things to yourself. We have the admonition in Acts Chapter 1 verse 8 saying you have received the power of Holy Ghost so that you become witnesses. That is it. That is the proving of that will.

So your job is to... you are not call to receive the power of Holy Ghost and just to sit down and keep it to yourself alone. You are just not to gather dust, don't allow it to gather dust; the power inside of you. You are to be a witness. You are to be a dispatch rider. You have to affect the people with the joy. You take it around. You spread it around.

We have when Philipp went to the city of Samaria, there was great joy, bringing the Word, and by this Word they were comforted. Bringing the word, you have to spread

it around, what is inside of you. So you are working as a witnesses. So He did not call us to be a spectator with this power. He did not call us to just be a robot, to just stay with... just for display. That is not for us. He want us to run with it. To be witness with is and that is about proving it.

Acts Chapter 1 verse 8 says the Holy Ghost has come upon us to be witnesses in these area. So even when in Judea and Samaria, we are not just to go and watch and be on the sideline and watch other people witnessing. Because some people that is their hobby now, they watch other people witnessing. Some they like commenting on other people witnessing. They don't know they are witnesses too. They should be up and doing about it. But they come to those side comments and run and say what is righteous is not right, criticizing or supporting and that kind of a thing. You have to witness. You should be about proving this, proving the will of God. Proving that which is deposited. Proving the new nature. Proving the eternal life that you have received.

Thank you for that insight. That is a great contribution to this thing.

And there is something you did talk about and I think this might be something that we need to elaborate a bit on. You see the reason why some Christians are on the sidelines when it comes to proving or demonstrating this will in this current world where we are is majorly because, some think well the reason why Apostle John or Apostle this or prophet that or that great man of God, the reason why great things are happening through their life and ministry is because those people are well acceptable to God more than they themselves. Some think well, I think if you ask somebody can God raise the dead? They say yes God can. But the question is can God used you to raise the dead? Then people begin to back off.

Now, it means then that is a kind of symptom, if that is the word. That is a kind of something like a sign of a malady, and the malady is of an un-renewed mind. That is the point. Because Romans Chapter 8 from verse 1 says there is therefore now, not later. Now! He says this is something you can be convinced about now.

There is therefore now, no condemnation, no disqualification.

Can you see?

for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Once you take that kind of verse and think about it, you are actually acting on Romans 12:2. You are renewing your mind. See! renewing your mind is so practical. You take Romans 8:1, **there is therefore now no condemnation for those who are Christ**

Jesus, you think about it. You meditate on it. You change your thinking so that by the time you come across a dead person or somebody who is in a terrible state. You can simply quote Ephesians 1 that says **the power that works in you as a Christian is the same mighty working power that raise Christ from the dead.**

And as you are about to lay hands upon the dead person, and the enemy speaks to your mind and say, you know what, that is not going to happen. You know that how many people have you prayed for? How far have you actually gone in the things of God? Have you seen the anointing of God that works in a raw manner? And the enemy comes and tries to convince you why that thing will not happened.

And then if your mind is not renewed, you will not be able to demonstrate that will of God. But if your mind is renewed and you know for those who are in Christ Jesus. There is therefore now no condemnation, nothing can stop you from approving or proving the will of God which in that case is resurrection.

So the point we are saying is this, it's so important. This is very critical for us as Christians. Jesus has said he has done the will. What are we supposed to do? Well, if It has been done, how do we do what has been done? That is what we are talking about. If it has been done, but there is something doing about what has been done. That means we need to demonstrate and show the world what has been done. And the only way to do that is just to get our mind renewed.

Yes, we should not just take pride in mindlessly just studying the Word. Some people can do some several hours now. So we have a situation now, where people are not reading, are not studying God's Word to know what the will of the Lord is. People are moving to studying, and people are studying the will of God, but they are not going to embrace opportunity to prove.

So we can have hours and hours of teaching of these things, and do mind renewal exercises. But everybody shying away from opportunity, or shying away from showing forth. Some even believe that it can't go together. They just feel you cannot study, they cannot get into the will of getting your heart and everything into the will of the Lord and keep doing this. These are powers...all those of kind of... in between this.

So we just have to know that we just have to get up from the couch. Studying... we need to prove this. We learn on the way. Because we cannot finish learning. Because some people said I have not learn enough, I have not read all the books, I have not listen to all the tapes. So let me do everything before I launch forth. You can't finish reading all these.

You can see the examples of Jesus with the Apostles. They did not finish, they learnt on the way. Some of the things you want to know about, the power about healings and everything, you learn it on the way. So they came to ask Jesus, why is it that we could not heal this? Why is it that we cannot do this? But you need to set out first.

So today we are just saying you have to get off the couch to go and prove. Because you are witnesses. As witnesses, you just have to be out there, where the actions is. You have to be where the actions is. They say the things we have seen and heard, the Word of life. So you need to show what you have received, that which I have. So you can't just be telling us what you have. You need to show just like Peter showed it at the beautify gate. That which I have. Not just...I give to you.

So you can have opportunities to give it out. That is a demonstration of the will. So it's not about just talking about it. So go out to give it what you have. I don't know if anybody is listening here, you want joy, as we sit here ministering to all needs. You have all needs met according to the will of the Lord. So this is an opportunity for demonstration to partake of this. We talked about things that are inheritance of the saints. That is what we invite you for. These things are waiting for demonstration.

What is your responsibility? Renew your mind according to the Word and get into business. Look for opportunities but make sure you get your mind renewed. Because the enemy will attack your mind at the point of demonstrating or proving that will. He is going to attack. He knows that your mind is where he can actually access. He can't actually access your spirit man.

The Bible says we are sealed with the Holy Ghost. You see? Until the redemption your spirit man is sealed. But your mind is not seal. Sorry! Your mind is not seal at all. And that is the battle ground of the devil. That is why he says unless the mind is renewed, there is no way you can prove or actually approve the will of God in your life.

So as you listen to this, what we are doing is a mind renewal. So you take time to go out, to go to the street, to go visiting, looking for situations and to be able to impact. Looking for places, people down and out, depressed, infect with joy that what is inside of you. Like Philip did in Acts Chapter 8, there was joy in the city.

Now, let's go on quickly to Ephesians Chapter 5.

Now, if you notice the trend in which this Expose is going, it will mean that even though Jesus said He has done the will of the Father. The Bible is saying that you should do what has been done.

You know people think about the fact that how do you do what has been done? Well, the will has been done by Jesus but there is something about doing what has been done. And that is what the believer is called into. It means you cannot do the will of God unless you know that the will has been done. So you are invited to do that which has been done. That is the basis.

Ephesians Chapter 5, you can read from verse 8, and we see the insight the Holy Ghost is going to give us.

We read from verse 8 to verse 21.

Ephesians 5

8. For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

Have you noticed he didn't say that you have light. He says now you are light. You are not having light, you will soon get light. He says you are light. That is your new status. That is why we say don't forget this is an expose on the will of God. You cannot do the will of God unless you know that the will has been done by Christ. So he is saying that you should know first that you are light in this world.

Go on please,

Walk as children of light:

I want a demonstration of the will. Somebody needs to prove. Can you see? It's not enough to say somebody is light. You need to show the light. Again, your community doesn't know you are light. Even though you are light, that is why he quickly added and said I need you to prove that will. I need to approve it. It is a file on your table waiting for approval. Approve it.

That is why you might want to say then why is Ephesians 5 writing? It was writing for their minds to be renewed. That is it. Because that is the transition between the will being done and somebody doing what has been done.

Go on please,

9. For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth

He is telling that the fruits of the spirit, the will that has been done in their spirit. He is telling what he has been. Please watch the strategy of Paul. He goes first to what has been done, and he tells them to do what has been done. That is it.

First what has been done, the next do what has been done. That is the pattern as we saw in Romans 12 verse 1

Go on please,

10. Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

I want to call your attention to Romans 12 that says that you may be able to prove the good, acceptable and perfect will of God. But look at what he says, prove... you see? Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, every matter should be established. Here he is using proving and previous verses he says walk in the light.

So if you are saying I want to know what... people say Father what is your acceptable will for my life? Father what is your perfect will for me? That is a prayer that is out... that prayer misses the point.

The Bible says if you walk in the reality of what you are, that is you proving what is acceptable, the will of God. That is way to prove it. So we are the one to prove it.

Go on please,

11. And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.

12. For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.

13. But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.

He says reprove them, please don't be too much in a hurry to think you should go out there and begin to condemn and point fingers on them. Because you have to read everything in context from previous verses. He says if you walk in the light, he says your life will make manifest the fact that they are living in darkness. You reprove them. Can you see?

So the reproving he is talking about is how you live your life. You cannot legislate morality as it were for people and try to control how they live their lives every day. But what you can do is how you shine as light to this world.

So he says if you walk in the light, he says it is light that makes darkness manifest. It exposes it. He says don't try to legislate morality on people. He says you walk in the light, it will reprove them that are in darkness. So that is what he says.

Again he is talking about you proving the will of God.

Go on please,

14. Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

Let just prove the will of God.

15. See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

16. Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

17. Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is.

Now, you don't need to be a grammatical giant for you to understand the whole context of understanding the will of God in this matter.

Now, again if you've been with us on previous transmission, our last episode before this. You begin to see that what the Bible calls the will of God doesn't seem to run in the same way as the mainstream understanding of what the will of God is. Here we see what he says in this case. He says don't be fools. Walk (**mark the word**) circumspectly, understanding what the will of the Lord is. If you ask me what is the will of the Lord in this case? You have to go all the way back talking about the fact that because you are light, then walk as light. That is you proving what is the acceptable will of God. That is you demonstrating the will.

It means the will of God in this case, he is asking you to know, to understanding the fact that what are you? Who are you? What has He made you to be? What is the done deal of Christ in your life? What has Christ made you? The Bible says in 1Corinthians, he says Christ had been made unto us, the wisdom and the power of God.

How can you say you are powerless? How can you say you are stupid? How can you say you are foolish? How can you say you are confused? He says if you are light, he says walk as one. He says if you are not walking as one, it means you don't understand what the will of the Lord is. Why don't you understand? Because you are not demonstrating what has been done. That is what he is saying.

So to understand the will of God, or to walk in the will of God or to do the will of God, the scripture is redefining our terminology of what it means for somebody to say they understand what God's will is, or they are doing the will of God in their life. This

is what it means to do the will of God. So if you want to do God's will, this is what you should be doing. It means you have to itemize, you have to list out, you have to get your mind renewed specifically on everything that has been done.

How did I know this? because Apostle Paul started by saying you are light in this world. Let us start from what has been done. Unless you know that, which will are you trying to do? I have seen people saying Father I want to do your will for my life, and you cannot itemize or articulate what has been done in Christ Jesus.

Don't forget this will we are talking about today, Christ has said with **allemphasis**, I have come to do the will of God. In fact in Hebrews Chapter 9, from verse 7 and verse 9, he reiterated twice and said I have come to do that will. So please the will has been done. But you are called to do what has been done. You are called to express or called to prove, called to manifest, called to show to the world what has been done in you. And Bible says your only gateway to that is a renewed mind, Romans Chapter 12 verse 2.

And that is the caution for those who might just be listening to this in part. May be they listen to "the Done Deal" yesterday and they are not listening to this. You cannot just take this word in isolation. So you need to follow as we go through. Because we cannot just say we've said everything about the will, so there is nothing for us to do. If you are listening to this today, so you need to listen to the one before, and you need to listen to the one that will be after. So all these things, they are not just in isolation. You need to bring them all together.

So that is what we see. So in this Ephesians Chapter 5 verse 17, it's so clear what he means to know the will of God for your life. It's so clear to know what it means to understand the will of God. You just start from verse 8 and read it all in agreement and you will know what it means.

So you can then boldly say well, I think I know... so it is high time Christians stop saying I don't what the will of God is for my life. Let me tell you how it sounds in the ears of God. If you say today Father I don't know your will for my life, I want to know. You know what you are saying? You are saying Father, am not even sure whether am light in this world, so therefore I can't even walk in the light anyway. That is what you are saying. That might not be what you meant to say, but that is what it means. That is why he says don't be a fool. That is what he says. You should

understand what the will is. You should know what has been done and then demonstrate it and prove it and that is what we see there.

So it means from today's transmission that life is coming to you, no more will you say I don't know the will of God for my life. No more will you say that I don't understand the will of God. All you need to do is get a renewed mind. Let your mind, your thinking agree with the Word. And Romans 12:2 guarantees you, you will be able to prove that will in your life. That is what we see there.

Yes, it's good that people know that the will of the Lord is broader than just looking to get a spouse, because that is what people have reduced the will of God to. Yes, if you stick with us, we are still going to get to there. That is why you have to stick with us. That is why we are taking it systematically. We are going to get there in further episodes, but people have to understand that, there are scriptures that talk about that. But people use the wrong scriptures for such things. This kind of scriptures does not even talk about that.

And then this is like knocking down some unnecessarily prayer points, because we see people in the place of prayer, they are asking Lord if it is your will, you want to heal this person. They have not actually renewed their mind on healing to know what is divine health, divine healing and all the provisions that came with redemption. To know that healing is part of it. So they spend some needless hour, needless time in praying to know whether is God's will to heal somebody, whether is God's will for somebody to prosper. So this is the hours that could have been used in mind renewal.

So we are calling you to mind renewal. You cannot afford to just jump into praying without really understanding this, what the will of the Lord is. So you don't want to be like that man, anyway Jesus has dealt a final blow to it, to answer every confusion. It is my will be cleansed. So it is the will of God even for your holiness. So it is the will of God, you need to understand what is the will of God. The Lord will be magnify who has taken delight in the prosperity of his servants. It is the will of the Lord. So there shouldn't be any controversy. It is already done and dusted. Done deal! So there shouldn't be any controversy or questions about what is the will of the Lord is.

Some people even still ask some ridiculous questions about should I need to preach this when you are already made a witness? You see, you just have to be like Paul. You need to know the will of the Lord that he that will that all men will be saved and come to the knowledge. That is the general will of the Lord for everyone. You go unless you

have a specific instruction, you must be on the motion. Unless you have a specific instruction like we saw in the life of Paul, withhold from going into this place. He just sense that he should go into another place. Yes, but there is a general will in which you can function. We have the platform in which you can function which is in the will.

So for those broad questions, you see some people still confuse. Instead of them sitting down and do the mind renewal exercise in which we are encouraging you to do, they turn it into prayer point and say Lord would you want this people to be saved? which is unnecessary.

Thank you for that insight.

There is something you mentioned and I think we might want to throw more light on that. 1Timothy2 where Apostle Paul said for God who want all men to be saved and to come to the saving knowledge of Christ Jesus. I know we quote such verses. It is good which is the reason why you cannot say you are not sure whether God want to save Mr A or Mr B.

Now, I want to know how did Paul know that, that was the will of God? You couldn't just take it hook line and sinker because Paul said it. Because Paul said himself, follow me as I follow Christ. How did Paul know that for God who wants all men to be saved?

Well, the reason why Paul knew that, it wasn't because he was a genius of a kind. You could have know the same thing as well. Because all Paul was did was to revert back to what Jesus said on the night He was betrayed by Judas. Jesus said not as I will but your will be done. So we know Jesus going to the cross that night. Jesus said that is the will of the Father being done.

All Apostle Paul has to do was to look at the implication of the will that Jesus said was done from that night where he was betrayed, Luke 22.

So it means all Paul did was look at the fact that Isaiah 53 says all of us like sheep have gone astray but God has laid upon him the iniquity of us all. So if Paul was able to connect the fact that Jesus said the will of God was done from that night when He was taking to the cross. Paul could then say whatever implication that night has, whatever it is, that is the will of God being done.

So Paul knew that if that night was the sins of the world being laid upon Jesus, all of us have gone astray and if that iniquity was laid upon him. So Paul then knew that it is the will of God then for all of us to be saved.

You have to look at where Christ said that the will was done. And look at the implication of that time, look at the implication of that reality of him going to the cross. Everything you can consider in the Word that is connected to that will being done that Jesus said in Luke 22, is everything that you can be guaranteed is God's will for your life. In fact, it gets better. It gets better because the Bible says that Will is already in force in your spirit. And all He is invited the believer to do is to prove it. It's to demonstrate. It's to do that will.

May I say that even for Jesus himself, Jesus Christ our Lord who is our model, cannot even function outside the will of the Lord. So He took his time to understand all what the will of the Lord is. And throughout his time on earth, He was able to show that it has been written of me. He was able to pick it out even when those disciples were with him does not even know. He was able to connect the dot's for them. That it is already written about me.

And we remember his entrance in that temple when he found the one that was written and said this is it. He really understood what the will is, and He said in your presence this is being fulfilled today. Because He really understood what the will of the Lord is. And he was able to quote copiously from the laws and the prophets. Often time, He had to say they say this of me when He was talking with the Apostles.

So if for Jesus he had to understand what the will is, He had to familiarize himself with it and all the time, He was able to talk about it. You cannot fulfill your destiny and purpose outside the will of the Lord, outside the knowledge of the Lord. So there is no crash course to understanding what the will of the Lord is. You have to do a mind renewal to know what it is about it. To know what the Lord has done, dusted so that you can walk in it. He was able to quote what was said of him in the book of Isaiah and he performed it. Just like he says you are the light, walk in it. So you need to really understand what it is for us to be able to walk in it.

Thank you for that insight.

Now, just a kind of summary of what we've been trying to say. Now, **the way Jesus did the will of the Father is not the same way you as a Christian will do the will of God.** And I think that is something we have to drop right there as a statement. It

might be shocking, are you saying you cannot follow like Jesus did? No! The way Jesus did the will of the Father cannot be the way you want to do the will of the Father.

The reason is this, that will of the Father they were praying about in Matthew 6:10 has been done. You are not there to say Father let me do your will on this earth. You can't! You can't do the will of the Father like Christ did.

Now, that being said. You are supposed to do the will of God, but the will of God you will do is because the will of God has been done. You are doing that which has been done. That is why it is always call prove the will of God. Can you see? You only prove. In science that is the word dokimázō that was meant to use for the word prove in Romans 12 also stand for examining, also stand for experiment. It is the same Greek Word. You cannot prove or you cannot experiment or you cannot examine that which doesn't exist.

So when a Christian says I want to do God's will for my life, what are you talking about? You can only do what has been done. You can only express.... He says you are light in this world, therefore walk as light. You cannot walk as light if you are not light in this world. That is why you see people trying to pray for somebody to be healed. He says am praying for Mr John be healed. You cannot do that unless you believed that Mr. John was healed. This is where so many confusion. You cannot do the will of God as a Christian unless you come from the backdrop of what has been done. You cannot stand in the place of Christ.

And that is why for you as a Christians your doing God's will is not in the same way as Christ did the will of the Father. That is why we are clarifying that.

Now, quickly let's go to 1John Chapter 2 and see an insight that we have there.

We can read from verse 12.

Again looking at more insight in the scriptures regarding the will of God.

1John 2

12. I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake.

13. I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father.

Now can you see? Done! Done! That is it.

So don't forget this's a discuss on the will of God. That is why I said is a different paradigm from what we might have been used to.

Go on please,

14. I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.

Known...Can you see that?

15. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Love not the world,

You know why this is amazing? because how can you say up to verse 14 what they are, what they have, you are strong. How can you tell them again what not to do? or how can you tell them...have you noticed this has become contradictory.

The reason is because up to verse 14 he was talking to the reality of what they have received in Christ Jesus. But unfortunately like we said, the world doesn't see all that, the fact that you are strong. He says that you overcome the wicked one, you have known the one that is from the beginning. You as a Christian you can say Oh yes, the devil is under my feet. The world doesn't know that. What the world knows is the demonstration of that will, that is what the world... that is why anytime he talks about the Will of God being prove, he mentioned the world. That is what we see in Romans Chapter 12. Do not be conformed to this world. Can you see again he talks about the world.

Go on please,

15. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Now he is talking to the renewal of the mind. See! The spirit and it is of the mind renewal.

Go on,

16. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

17. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

This is where some Christians pick verses that say we have to do the will of God for our lives.

Now, before you do that, I know the word doeth there, if you have a KJV, he used the word doeth or you have other version he used the word does, which means he is talking about a continuous tense.

I know in our last transmission when we began to say the will of God has been done already, when we say things like that, somebody can say excuse me, how can you say the will of God is already done when the Bible says we still have to do the will of God? And we agree with you. Thank God that you mentioned that. It is there. The Bible says you as a Christian you need to do because the word doeth there is the word does, which means is something that we need to do currently.

Now, question you are asking is this why? Why do we then say the will has been done when the Bible says we need to do the will of God 1John 2:17? Am glad you asked.

Now I think the confusion in that is simply the fact that the way we understand the word **do**, what a Christians does in terms of doing the will of God, most of us tend to use an old covenant mirror or old covenant lens to understand and interpret the word **do**. This is where the problem is. How a Christian does the will of God in the New Covenant is not the same way how Elijah, how Zechariah, Hezekiah will do the will of God? What does it mean to do the will of God in the New Covenant?

Now, follow us quickly as we clarify the word **do**... Now please you want to join us in the next transmission as we begin to explore what does it mean to do as a Christian?

You want to stick with us in our next transmission as we begin to elucidate what it means to do what has been done. That is it.

So what does it means to do the will of God for you as a Christian? We will actually go on with that fully in our next transmission.

So just telling us about this will of God, we are not done yet. Because we started the done deal, in case you missed it and this mind renewal exercise and then to know what it means to do. (Doing what has been done)

Because of time we will not be able to do that. But am going to do like Apostle John here and be able to address and call you out as you are, saying some people see the Father as terrors unto to good works, you see them as people that do not understand. Some people make jest and make mockery of them that they don't understand, they are ignorant, but we see Apostle John was saying to them that you know the one that is from the beginning.

So we are calling you for who you are, that you know that inside of you, you know who that is from the beginning. It is for you to prove it out. The proving is on just you. The burden of the proof is on you, to prove that you know from the beginning. So you have that knowledge. So you are not really confuse, you know what the salvation is, you know everything. You are to approve it. You are to prove it.

So we are calling you out for who you are. And he says to the young men, so our young men are not ignorant, he says they are strong, they are not weak, and they know the Word of God, the Word of God abides in them. These are people that have the Word enduring in them. So they are not giving to all frivolities. They are not giving to entertainment because that is what the scriptures say. They have the Word in them. They are strong and they have overcome the wicked one. So these are overcomers.

So we are calling out the overcomers. And the burden is just for you to prove it. Just go and show it. The file is on your table waiting for approval. Show that you are strong. Show that the Word abides in you. Show that you have overcome. That is just it.

And that is what this word is calling us to. That is a mind renewal exercise in which we are engaging you to, to really know who you are and then for you to show it. To prove it. This is where we are going to stop.
